## *PART 61:*

### **40 Hours Total Time**

#### 20 Hours Dual

- 3 hours dual cross-country
- 3 hours dual night
- Dual night cross-country over 100 NM total distance
- 10 takeoffs and landings to a full stop

#### 10 Hours Solo

- 5 hours solo cross-country
- One cross-country of at least 150 NM total distance with full stop landings at a minimum of three points. One segment must be at least 50 NM.
- 3 takeoffs and landings to a full stop at an airport with an operating control tower.

## *PART 141:*

### **35 Hours Total Time**

#### 20 Hours Dual

- 3 hours dual cross-country
- 3 hours night
- Dual night cross-country over 100 NM total distance
- 10 takeoff and landings to a full stop
- 3 hours instrument flight
- 3 hours practical test preparation within 60 days

#### 5 Hours Solo

- One cross-country of at least 100 NM total distance with full stop landings at a minimum of three points. One segment must be at least 50 NM.
- 3 takeoffs and landings to a full stop at an airport with an operating control tower.
